### 1.- Papagayo Beach

It is one of the most famous beaches of Lanzarote, known for its turquoise waters and golden sand. It is located in the Natural Park of the Ajaches, which gives it an impressive natural environment. To access the beach, you must pay a fee for the use of the access road, which is usually 3 € per vehicle.



### 2.- Las Salinas del Janubio

These salt mines have been in operation for centuries, located in an impressive landscape of volcanoes and sea. Here you can see how salt is extracted in the traditional way. Admission is free, but there is an interpretation center if you want to learn more about the process, which costs between 2 € and 4 € per person.









### 3.- Los Hervideros

The Hervideros are volcanic cliffs formed by lava meeting the sea, creating an impressive natural spectacle when the waves collide with the rocks. Admission is free.


### 4.- El Golfo

El Golfo is a small coastal town. It is a very picturesque place with a lookout point and restaurants nearby.

### 5.- Charco Verde (Playa de los Silos - El Golfo)

It is a small beach famous for its pool of green water. The algae present in this water give it its characteristic color.





### 6.- La Geria

La Geria is a wine region of Lanzarote famous for its unique landscape of vineyards planted in holes dug in the volcanic soil, surrounded by stone walls. Here you can do wine tastings and visit wineries. Entrance to the area is free, but tastings usually cost between 5 € and 15 € depending on the winery.

### 7.- Parque Nacional de Timanfaya

Timanfaya is one of the main tourist attractions of Lanzarote, a natural park that shows the power of volcanic activity. There are several ways to explore the park, such as the tourist bus tour and guided tours. The entrance fee is 12€ for adults.







### 8.- Teguise

Teguise is one of the most historic towns of Lanzarote, with cobblestone streets and traditional architecture. The Teguise market, held on Sundays, is one of its main attractions. Access to the town is free, although if you want to take a guided tour or enter a museum, prices can vary between 2 € and 5 €.

### 9.- Famara Beach

It is an extensive beach of golden sand, ideal for water sports such as surfing. Access is free, and the beach offers an excellent view of the Risco de Famara, an impressive cliff.






### 10.- El Charco de San Ginés (Arrecife)

This small salt lake is located in the heart of the capital, Arrecife. Surrounded by fishing boats and with restaurants all around, it is a picturesque place to stroll. Admission is free, and it is a popular place with locals and tourists alike.





### 11.- Cueva de los Verdes

The Cueva de los Verdes is an impressive volcanic cave, famous for its geological formations and local stories. You can take a guided tour, which generally costs 10€ per adult and 5€ for children.



### 12.- Jameos del Agua

This is one of the most spectacular places created by the artist César Manrique. It is a tourist and cultural complex inside a volcanic tunnel, which includes an auditorium, a restaurant and a lake with endemic blind crabs. The entrance fee is usually €10 per adult and €5 for children.



### 13.- LagoMar Museum

The Lagomar Museum is a house built in a volcanic cave, designed by the architect Jesús Soto. It is located in Nazaret and offers a unique view of the architecture of Lanzarote. The entrance fee is 6€ for adults and 4€ for children.



### 14.- Mirador del Río

Located on the northern tip of Lanzarote, also designed by César Manrique. From here you can enjoy a spectacular view of the island of La Graciosa and the Strait of El Rio. The entrance fee is 4€ per adult and 2€ per child.





### **GASTRONOMY**

### LANZAROTE

In Lanzarote, the gastronomy is strongly influenced by the sea, the volcanic land and the Canarian tradition. Here is a list of some of the typical products and dishes that you can not miss during your visit:



#### 1. Papas arrugadas

This is one of the most representative dishes of the Canary Islands. Small potatoes that are cooked with a lot of salt in their skin until they are wrinkled. They are usually served with mojo, a very typical sauce, which can be green (coriander and garlic) or red (bell pepper and chilli).



#### 2. Gofio

Gofio is a cereal flour (usually corn or wheat) that is toasted. It is a staple of the Canarian diet and is used in both sweet and savory dishes. It can be eaten with milk, in soups, or even in desserts. (In the photo, Gofio escaldado)



#### 3. Pescado fresco

Due to Lanzarote's location in the Atlantic Ocean, fresh fish is one of the main delicacies of the island. Among the most common are bream, wreckfish, tuna and mackerel. These are prepared on the grill, in calderetas (fish stew) or in salt.



#### 4. Queso majorero

Although originally from Fuerteventura, majorero cheese is enjoyed throughout the Canary Islands, including Lanzarote. It is a goat's milk cheese with a soft or cured texture, often seasoned with paprika or herbs. It is ideal for eating alone, in tapas, or as an accompaniment to other dishes.

#### 5. Ropa Vieja

This dish is very popular throughout the Canary Islands and is prepared with shredded beef or chicken, chickpeas, potatoes and vegetables. It is a tasty and very nutritious stew, ideal for family meals.



#### 6. Conejo en salmorejo

This is another traditional dish from Lanzarote and the Canary Islands in general. The rabbit is cooked in a sauce of garlic, white wine, peppers, tomato, cumin and spices, which gives it an incredibly tasty flavor. It is usually served with potatoes or rice.



#### 7. Almogrote

Almogrote is a paste or cream made with cured cheese, garlic, red bell pepper, olive oil and salt. It is usually served with bread or as an appetizer in tapas.



### 8. Tarta de queso de cabra

In Lanzarote, we also prepare delicious desserts such as goat cheese cake, which uses majorero cheese as a base for a unique flavor. It is usually smooth and creamy, with a touch of honey.



#### 9. Vino de Lanzarote

The island has a very particular wine tradition, due to its volcanic soil. The Denomination of Origin Lanzarote produces unique wines, especially white wines, such as Malvasia. These wines have a special taste due to the growing conditions in the fields of La Geria. Don't forget to try the local wine!

Montaña Roja 5.5 km - 2h

It is the southernmost volcano on the island, with stunning views of Playa Blanca.



Femés - Playa Quemada 8km - 2h

It offers spectacular views of the Atlantic Ocean and Los Ajaches Natural Monument at all times.



Caldera Colorada 3 km - 1.5h

An imposing volcano tinged with spectacular reddish colors. The advantage of this tour is that its surface is practically flat.



#### Playa Blanca - Punta Papagayo 8km - 2h

It is a simple route, passing by impressive beaches and coves. It is a claim in white beach which can also be accessed by car.

The best starting point is the Hotel Sandos Papagayo.



Caldera Blanca y La Caldereta 10km - 4h30


It is one of the most impressive volcanoes on the island. The starting point is a parking lot located on a dirt road called "Camino del Cráter", near the Ermita de los Dolores.

### **ACTIVITIES**



#### 1.- Snorkel

Many companies offer excursions where you can snorkel in the crystal clear waters around Lanzarote, and discover the marine life up close!

Price: 35€ - 45€ per person.

### 2.- Boat trip

There are several boat excursions that are perfect; such as to La Graciosa, catamaran trips or glass bottom boat trips. These excursions usually include time to swim, see dolphins and enjoy the scenery.

Price: Approximately 30€ - 50€ per adult, with discounts for children.





### 3.- Open air cinema

The only open air cinema in Lanzarote at Rooftop Biosfera, Puerto del Carmen. With food and beverage service from the seat.



## LANZAROTE with kids



**1.- Lanzarote Aquarium** in Costa Teguise is perfect for a family activity. It offers the opportunity to see a wide variety of marine species, including sharks, rays, turtles and tropical fish. It also has interactive activities that children will really enjoy. Price approx: 9€ adults, 5€ children (3 to 12 years old).



### 2.- Aquapark Costa Teguise (open seasonally)

located in Costa Teguise, ideal for the whole family. It offers a variety of slides, pools and play areas for all ages, from areas for small children to exciting attractions for the more adventurous. It is a perfect place to enjoy a day of fun and refreshment in a relaxed atmosphere.

Price approx: 18€ adults, 13€ children (4 to 12 years old).



#### 3.- Rancho Texas Lanzarote Park

A theme park and zoo where you can see exotic animals such as dolphins, sea lions and birds of prey. It also offers dolphin and sea lion shows, as well as children's play areas. In addition, there is a pool area and slides for children to enjoy.

Price approx: 29€ adults, 22€ children.



#### 4.- Underwater in Lanzarote

If you are looking for a unique experience, a submarine excursion can be a fascinating option. The Puerto Calero submarine takes visitors to explore the marine life of Lanzarote through the submarine's crystals.

Price approx: 50€ per adult, 30€ per child.




